

**14. DIRECT CREMATION (without ceremony) ----- \$ 1,555.00**

This fee includes the following:

- o Basic services of the funeral director and staff
- o Initial transfer of the deceased from the place of death
- o Final viewing for positive identification
- o Cremation pouch
- o First 24 hours of temperature controlled storage
- o Local transportation to the crematory
- o Crematory Fee

*Adirondack-Burlington Cremation Service (the crematory) is owned and operated by the Ready family so your loved one never leaves our care.*

If you want to arrange for direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of corrugated cardboard.

- Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser ----- \$ 1,555.00
- Direct cremation with minimum cardboard container----- \$ 1,605.00

These prices include some outside charges such as the crematory fee, the fee for the Medical Examiner Permit and the Vermont Burial Transit Permit. Any other items you may choose will be added to the above services.

**15. BODY DONATION TO A MEDICAL SCHOOL OR FACILITY --- DO NOT OFFER**

This charge for assisting in the University Of Vermont College Of Medicine Anatomical Gift Program (without ceremony) includes:

- o Professional services of the funeral director and staff
- o Initial transfer of the deceased from the place of death
- o Transportation to UVM College of Medicine Anatomy Lab  
*Currently this charge is paid for by UVM College of Medicine*

16. "Our basic service charge includes a \$6.00 fee that will be sent to the State of Vermont and set aside for the protection of funeral service customers." *This fee is currently suspended by the State of Vermont.*

▪ **BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF -----\$ 1,075.00**

This fee includes the following:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call
- Initial transfer of the deceased from the place of death
- Professional services of the funeral director and staff
- Sanitary care of remains when in our custody
- Final viewing for positive identification
- Cremation pouch
- First 24 hours of temperature controlled storage
- Local transportation to the crematory

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. A portion of this fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) (#14)

**1. EMBALMING ----- DO NOT OFFER**

- Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

**2. OTHER PREPARATION OF THE BODY**

- Cosmetology, dressing and placement of the deceased in the casket -----DO NOT OFFER
- Restoration of autopsied remains (includes embalming) -----DO NOT OFFER
- Embalming of organ/tissue/bone donors-----DO NOT OFFER
- Special restoration or treatment if required for viewing ----- \$ 150.00
- Removal and disposal of pacemaker for cremation ----- \$ 50.00
- Temperature controlled storage per day after initial 24 hours ----- \$ 75.00

**3. ADDITIONAL SERVICE AND FACILITY FEES**

- a. Facilities and staff for viewing or visitation (up to 4 hours)-----DO NOT OFFER
  - i) Staff and equipment for visitation at place other than funeral home -----DO NOT OFFER
- b. Facilities and staff for private viewing by the family limited to 30 minutes----- \$ 125.00
- c. Facilities and staff for memorial service in the funeral home-----DO NOT OFFER
- d. Facilities and staff for funeral service in the funeral home-----DO NOT OFFER
  - i) Facilities and staff for funeral or memorial service (day after visitation) -DO NOT OFFER

When burial cannot take place in Winter months, this fee includes the use of the hearse from place of storage to cemetery and professional services and staff for committal service.

**4. TRANSFER OF REMAINS TO FUNERAL HOME -----INCLUDED**

- Our removal policy includes vehicle use as required by State Regulations and vehicle licensing standards; including appropriately trained and licensed personnel.

**5. AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT**

- a. Use of hearse for transportation to place of disposition -----DO NOT OFFER
- b. Use of five passenger sedan -----DO NOT OFFER
- c. Use of service car for staff and or bearers, clergy and flowers -----DO NOT OFFER
- d. Additional mileage charge; Transportation beyond local area is charged at \$ 3.00 per mile, one way. Unless otherwise noted, all transportation charges contained in the General Price List apply to local area only within 25 mile radius of the funeral home.

- **Receiving of cremated Remains -----DO NOT OFFER**
  - Consultation with the family or responsible party
  - Coordinating service plans with clergy, cemetery and or other parties involved in the final disposition of the cremated remains.
  - This fee for our services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.

**12. IMMEDIATE BURIAL (without ceremony) ----- DO NOT OFFER**

  - Immediate burial with minimum casket ----- DO NOT OFFER
